Through the Maine Families Program, this Parent Education Professional delivers the Parent as Teachers™ evidence-based model which is based on respected research findings with numerous studies demonstrating the following positive outcomes: increased parent knowledge of development, early detection of developmental delays, increased school readiness and prevention of child abuse and neglect as a basis. Parent Education Professionals also build protective factors that serve as buffers to reduce risk to young children, prenatal to age five, and families. These protective factors include parental resilience, knowledge of child development and parenting skills, social connections, and social-emotional competence of children. This model is designed to be delivered in the homes of parents or virtually through Zoom. This position works with families in Lincoln County. **Typical hiring range for this soft-money funded position is \$46,000 - \$50,000 commensurate with qualifications and experience.**

The Parent Education Professional will work remotely and in the field, with a homebase in the Knox/Lincoln County Extension Office at 377 Manktown Road, Waldoboro. Travel within Lincoln County is required.
